In May 1940, Britain was on the verge of major military disaster during the Second World War. 400,000 army soldiers were confined by German soldiers in a small area in the French port of Dunkirk. German tanks were only 10 miles away from capturing 400,000 soldiers.

However, by 4 June, over 338,000 soldiers had been evacuated to England. The evacuation exercise was made possible by willingness of civilians who offered their leisure and fishing boats to ferry the troops from the shallow beach of Dunkirk.

Every boat which was used, no matter how small it was, played a key role in saving lives. It is a fascinating story which reminds us of the Great Commission. We have a role to play in the Great Gospel Commission. 2 Timothy 2:21 remind us that we are vessels for honor; sanctified and useful to the Master, prepared for every good work.

If we are willing to lend our time and talents, we can play a key role in saving lives. It is my prayer, that we take serious heed of the gospel commission and preach the Word till the Second Coming of our Lord Jesus Christ.
