THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK:

Which day is the most important in your life?

Did you get caught out by the clocks changing to Summer Time last Sunday? I forgot to warn you last Sabbath about the clocks going one hour forward on Sunday.

It is an important day, but is it the most important? It may have caused you some panic if you had an appointment or work and you found out you were an hour late!

But to answer the question I have posed; the Bible tells me that today is the most important. Hebrews 4:7 (NIV) God again set a certain day, calling it "Today." This he did when a long time later he spoke through David, as in the passage already quoted: "Today, if you hear his voice, do not harden your hearts." Simply, today is the day of our salvation.
