### WEEKLY THOUGHT

No temptation has overtaken you except what is common to mankind. And God is faithful; he will not let you be tempted beyond what you can bear. But when you are tempted he will also provide a way out so that you can endure it. 1 Corinthians 10:13. This is a profound promise Paul make about God. How can one know that the challenge they are faced with is common to mankind, for we are all individuals and unique in strength and the way we view things. How can we certainly know that we will be able to bear the temptation we are faced with? To help us let me share a few bible characters who faced difficult situations, but were able to bear them, or their situation changed.

Joseph was thrown into a pit, Genesis 37: 24, but did not stay in forever verse 28 'lifted him out of the pit'. Neither did he stay forever in prison.

Gen 39:20. 41:14 '...quickly brought him out...'

Shadrach, Meshach and Abednego did not stay forever in the fire. The fire had no strength to consume them. Dan. 3:26 '...came forth of the midst of the fire'. So it was with Daniel the lions lost appetite and spent a night with him in a den. Dan. 6:23 '... so Daniel was taken out of the lions 'den'. In the New Testament we see Bartimaeus refused to be silenced until his sight was restored. Mark 10:52 '...your faith has healed you'.

These few Bible characters' experiences and I know there are many more, tell me that wherever you are just now, you will not remain there forever. One way or the other God will find or give you a way out or a way to bear it. Therefore, whatever temptation you are going through, do not give up your faith or let your faith and hope die. Do not allow the voices of temptation get louder than the voice of Gods promise. He is faithful '...he will not let you be tempted beyond what you can bear. But when you are tempted he will also provide a way out so that you can endure it'. Take God on his promise, and soon you will be out of that situation, if not he will give you a way to bear it. If your marriage seem to be in the rocks it won't stay there forever; having problems with children or parents this too will not stay the same forever; facing trouble at work, it will improve one day; sick, God will be there with you. In a nutshell, whatever situation you are in, God will provide a way to bear it. This is the promise of God recorded in his Holy Bible.
