Where have you placed your trust?

It seems nowadays, that if you want to drive somewhere new, you must have at least two important things. First, a Satnav, and second, the postcode of your destination! Once the postcode is entered, the Satnav is ready to guide you by the quickest route. So off you go, confident that the voice from the speaker will guide you safely, warn of any problems lying ahead, and correct you if you make a wrong turn.

Now, I am not against modern technology, but I do like a good old-fashioned road map. I love to pour over the route I want to take memorising road numbers and junctions. I do use modern technology to help me recognise important road signs and landmarks, and this is where Google Earth comes into its own. I can go down to ground level and actually see the road sign and road layout.

I am sure that all you Satnav users are smiling to yourselves and thinking, 'How complicated he is making it all. Just buy a Satnav and enjoy the freedom it gives!' But, what about the time the voice from the box directed you up a muddy rutted farm track to nowhere! Or directed you down a dead-end road! And what do you do when the Satnav cuts out altogether?

This is where my old-fashioned look, read and memorise method really pays off. Even the inventor of the Satnav encourages people to learn to read maps and not become too dependent on technology.

How true this can be of our spiritual journey. Have we become too dependent on other people to guide us, or even the church? To those who are being baptised today, Jesus says, 'Follow me.' Don't rely on anyone else - not even the church - to guide you. He says, 'I am the way the truth and the life.' Unlike a Satnav, Jesus never fails!
