THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK

How Shall I Wait?

But those who wait on the Lord^[SEP] Shall renew their strength.^[SEP] They shall mount up with wings like eagles.^[SEP] They shall run and not be weary.^[SEP] They shall walk and not faint. (Isaiah 40:31)

I cannot shake it off; like an earworm I keep hearing it in my head. It has now become one of my most treasured passages. This well-known passage communicates a profound truth. There is always a positive outcome for all who wait on God. The passage speaks volumes of the benefit of waiting. If we wait we shall renew our strength, if we wait we shall be carried up with wings like eagles, if we wait we will run and not get tired, if we wait we will walk and not faint. While the Bible frequently speaks of waiting in a positive light our society today detest waiting. Waiting is ubiquitous. We wait in traffic, we wait for the train, we wait for the bus, we wait in the check out queues, and we wait in our GP's surgery. Although waiting is an important part of our lives, waiting is now a difficult and painful experience because of technology. The inability to wait has caused many societal problems. Is it possible that waiting is essential for character development? Can I for a moment entertain the thought that waiting can be transformative?

Have you recently been to see your GP or expecting a call regarding a test results. Perhaps you have taken an exam and you are waiting for that crucial result. You might have just had an interview and waiting for the outcome. Most of us, if not all, have had similar experiences of waiting. You know what I am talking about. How can we wait on the Lord? Our waiting can be full, rich and exciting and not painful, empty and dull.

We are expected to wait silently and expectantly. Waiting silently is the willingness to listen. Waiting expectantly is waiting in hope. When we wait silently and expectantly we are open to hear Him; we are receptive to His voice in diverse ways. Pastor Rick Warren shares some useful gems regarding how to wait. He mentioned 4 ACTS which we can engage in while waiting. Waiting does not have to be passive. The first Act is **W**—I should write down the lesson I am learning during this period. Writing helps me to remember (Num 33:2). It helps me to listen attentively and reflectively. During a time of crises it is an opportunity to be willing to be taught by the great teacher. There is something to learn if I want to. Keeping a journal or diary is an excellent way to document one's thoughts. The second Act is **A**—I should act as though I have already have it (Mark 11:24). This is faith. The third Act is **I**—Imitate the habit that grows strong faith (praying, serving, believing, sowing, and fellowshiping). We all learn best by modelling (Philippians 4:9). **T**—Trust God instead of panicking. We should not give up (Gal 6:9). God is never in a hurry or late and He will never give up on us.

As we face another week waiting in God's waiting room remember the acrostic, **WAIT**—**W**rite, **A**ct, **I**mitate and **T**rust. May He help us to utilise these gems in order that our waiting may transform and develop our character.
