THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK:

Miscommunication

If you had asked me yesterday what are homonyms were I would have said are they flowers don't they look like Dandelions. A homonym is a word sounding the same but spelt differently like by, buy and bye. All with different meanings and when spoken if it was not for the sentence you would have no idea what I was meaning.

Words are powerful things and there are 126 verses in the bible reminding us of the careful use of our tongue and what we say the majority of them are in Proverbs such as: "The lips of the righteous know what is fitting, but the mouth of the wicked is only perverse" (Proverbs 10 v 32 NIV) and "An evil man is trapped by his sinful talk, but a righteous man escapes trouble" (Proverbs 12 v 13NIV).

Even those who followed Jesus misunderstood Jesus and what His mission was, in Mark 14 v 17 (NIV) Jesus "Aware of their discussion, Jesus asked them: "Why are you talking about having no bread? Do you still not see or understand?" referring to them not understanding the message from feeding the 4,000 and 5,000 and have baskets left over. Also in Matthew 16 v 21 & 22 (NIV): "From that time on Jesus began to explain to his disciples that he must suffer many things at the hands of the elders, chief priests and teachers of the law, and he must be killed and on the third day be raised to life. Peter took him aside and began to rebuke him. "Never, Lord!" he said. "This shall never happen to you."

As Christians we need to ensure that the Gospel message is not misunderstood because of what we have said, and to do this we first must ask God to guide us is what to say and how to say it. As Christians we have words very familiar to us but to anyone outside the church they will have no idea what the message is, like in 1 Peter 3 v 11 (KJV) "Let him eschew evil, and do good: let him seek peace, and ensue it." or Romans 7 v 8 (KJV) "But sin, taking occasion by the commandment, wrought in me all manner of concupiscence. For without the law sin was dead." I will leave you pondering over these verses.
