## **THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK:**

Do Justice

This is what the LORD says: Do what is just and right. Rescue from the hand of his oppressor the one who has been robbed. Do no wrong or violence to the alien, the fatherless or the widow, and do not shed innocent blood in this place. *Jeremiah 22:3-5*

I was attending a conference this week, where communicators around the world collaborate with our entities working in hard conditions to help those who flee from danger. ADRA is more than an entity for whom we collect money. I was impressed by some of the reports that came from very dangerous areas of our world. What is clear is that there is a lot of injustice in our world. Millions of girls in many places are unable to go to school. This is because boys get the privilege over girls to go, as their parents think that boys have a better chance to make a living when they grow up.

Girls then are given away to be married from around the age of 9 and become parents themselves, often of more than one child by the time they are 12 or 15. Their husbands, often much older than them, will then decide to upgrade and get a new young bride. This means that these girls would then be left to look out for themselves and somehow find food and shelter.

This is injustice on a major scale, and ADRA is right there on the ground, helping to educate and help families who are broken because of this. This is only one of many operations that ADRA is involved with.

But we can help, even though we are perhaps geologically far removed from some of these places. We can help ADRA, not only by of course making contributions and ingathering, but also by signing a petition that is geared to present to authorities and influential people in these regions in the hope that they will be able to help our organisations to help these families through education and provision.

For every child that is not able to be in school, another family is represented that will be broken, another girl bound to be without a family, work and livelihood, and probably die much too young. The theme that the collaborators have chosen to not only help deal with this issue, but for all of our communication over the next few years is very clever. It is the theme: 20 for 7.

20 for 7: 20 million Seventh-day Adventists working for 7 billion members of this planet. What is it you have done for someone near you lately? Have you been able to do any kind of evangelism? Have you been in a position to do any of what the text above suggests? We can do what is right, we can do justice by standing up for those who are oppressed.
