## THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK:

### Fruit-full

I have been told that in the world there are two kinds of living things: producers and consumers. Producers are living organisms like plants and trees. They produce their own food through the process of photosynthesis to turn the raw materials such as water and Carbon dioxide in the presence of light, chlorophyll and certain enzymes into sugar and oxygen. The sugar which they produce is used to fuel plants as they grow. Animals, on the other hand, are consumers because they can't make their own food even though some are capable of cooking. Consumers consume food which their bodies use as fuel for energy. They are three different consumers in the world: herbivores, carnivores and omnivores.

While plants produce to survive, human beings consume to survive. God wants us to be producers of fruit—not bananas and mangoes but the "fruit of the spirit." In Galatians 5:22-23 we find one of the most beautiful passages in the New Testament: "But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, forbearance, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control. There are 9 characteristics that are listed. They are three sets of threes---three triads of virtues or attitudes.

It is noteworthy that the noun, "fruit," in the expression "fruit of the spirit" is in the singular in contrast to "gifts" in the phrase "gifts of the spirit." While the "gifts" of the spirit focuses on what a person does the "fruit" emphasises on the character of the person. The singular noun highlights singularity of purpose. The purpose is to unite the community of believers. The fruit doesn't bring diversity the way the gifts do. The fruit unifies. There is only one fruit of the Spirit. It is His life that is reproduced in us.

We cannot produce the fruit on our own. The source is the Holy Spirit. Plants can only produce fruits when the raw materials and essential requirements such as carbon dioxide, water and sunlight are present. Similarly, we must expose ourselves to His word and the light of His love. We must stay connected to Him. What an amazing community it would be when we are fruit-ful and exhibit the fruit of the Spirit: Love, Joy, Peace, Forbearance, Kindness, Goodness, Faithfulness, Gentleness and Self-Control. Only God can make us truly "fruit-ful. May the Lord continue to nourish us daily so that we can produce His kind of fruit.
