**THOUGHT**

Six weeks ago, our lives changed drastically. Paula suffered a stroke which has left her with little feeling down the whole of her left side. However, we have much to praise God for in that she has not lost the ability to move her hand, arm and leg, so is able to walk and do many things for herself and around the house.

These are good positive advances, but they come with their own challenges, the greatest of these is pain. How can a hand, arm and leg have no feeling, yet they are filled with pain? It is easy to ask the question, but much more difficult to give an answer.

What lessons have Paula and I learned from our current experience? First, treasure today and make the most of it, because in a second, all can change.

Second, medical science is marvellous, but it does not have the answer to every question we may ask concerning our physical wellbeing, but we know someone who does, God!

Third, and this is a very hard one, be patient! God designed our bodies to repair themselves, sometimes this happens quickly, sometimes it may take a very long time. Psalm 27:14 (NLT) 'Wait patiently for the LORD. Be brave and courageous. Yes, wait patiently for the LORD.'

Fourth, the concern and love of family, friends and fellow church members is also very precious, and a very important element in the healing process.

Five, a merry, cheerful heart does work as a very effective medicine. Proverbs 17:22 (NLT) 'A cheerful heart is good medicine, but a broken spirit saps a person's strength.' Not easy, when there is pain and discomfort, but when surrounded by cheerful doctors and nurses, family and friends, healing definitely speeds up.
