## THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK

### Perfect Timing – part 2

How much training does one need to be prepared to proclaim the Gospel of Salvation? It is a good question, but hard to answer. If we look at the life of Jesus, we can see that as a twelve year old, he had a profound knowledge of the scriptures and his destiny as a proclaimer of the good news of salvation. He certainly made the rabbis sit up and think. But was it the right time for him to become a full time proclaimer of the Gospel?

Jesus spent the next eighteen years learning to be patient and work hard while witnessing to everyone he came in contact with. At the perfect time he was baptised and started his specific ministry.

As I read through the account of the early life of Jesus presented to us by Mrs White in her book, Desire of Ages, I realised that the eighteen years Jesus spent working as a carpenter before starting his full time ministry was to teach him a lesson he had not learned at the age of twelve. In those intervening years, he learned how to deal with people. At twelve, in his enthusiasm he hit the Rabbis with hard truth they could not swallow. At thirty, he could speak to a Samaritan woman at the well in a way she understood and could accept.

Here is a lesson for us to learn, enthusiasm to impart truth must be preceded by learning to love and understand people! Then, at the right time, God will show us the ministry he wants us to be involved in. Isaiah 40:31 (KJV) *‘But they that wait upon the LORD shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings as eagles; they shall run, and not be weary; and they shall walk, and not faint.’* The old saying is still true, ‘Fools rush in where angels fear to tread.’

The most important time is veiled by God, the time of Jesus’ second coming. Just as his birth took place at the right time, so will his coming again. We are advised by God not to speculate on the timing of this event, but to concentrate on being ready for it. His advice is: Luke 19:13 (KJV) ‘Occupy till I come.’ Use the time we have wisely in prayer, preparation and proclamation of the good news of salvation.

At the perfect time, Jesus will come again!
