I like things to begin on time and end on time! This is despite the rumour my mother spread abroad that I would be late for my own funeral! Well, I was a bit of a dreamer in my childhood days and time did not seem to be in short supply then. But now, time is in short supply: I have far less in front of me than has passed behind me.

We do not like to be kept waiting. Don't you find it annoying when someone makes an appointment and fails to come on time and you are left waiting, unable to do anything else but wait, in case you miss them? How about those frustrating phone calls we make only to hear a message, "Your call is important to us, please hold, and an operator will be with you soon." And then that terrible music starts! If our call is important, why is it not answered immediately?

God is amazing! He started each day of creation on time and finished it on time! Jesus came exactly on time and died to save us exactly on time, and He will come again exactly in God's appointed time!


