### Pathfinders' Experiences

The Seventh-day Adventist Church is committed to understanding young people and training its youth for leadership and service to humanity. The Pathfinder Club is a church-centred spiritual-recreational-activity program designed for young people 10 to 15 years of age. One of the objectives of pathfinding is to foster the harmonious development of the physical, social, intellectual, and spiritual life of the Pathfinder.

**Joel tells his story** on Outdoor Activities: "At the end of August 2013 some of the Pathfinders from Dundee SDA Church attended a Camporee in Dumfries. When we had got to the New Galloway Centre I was really tired, it was a long and bumpy journey. I got to the tent and left my bag there. When I went to find my mum and my brother I got lost a bit. I heard people laughing and I felt lonely but I found my mum and my brother. Next morning it was Saturday so we had to change into our Pathfinder uniform. We did marching and we signed up for different activities.

At night time Akeyo played his clarinet and it was good. When I got into my sleeping bag a wasp stung me and I shouted OUCH!!!! It was really sore. Sunday was the best day because we got to do sports. First we did climbing, my brother got up first because he went up first. I got up too and went down the zip wire. Next was archery, it is not as easy as it looks but I enjoyed it. Then it was laser quest, it was shooting but you never got hurt I shot 6 people, my team lost every game but it was fantastic. The second last event was sailing I was steering and it was fun I fell in once and it was funny. The last event was the water park, nearly everybody fell in the water and we saw Jordan do a flip on the trampoline. We got to jump into the water it was terrific I had really good fun.

This experience taught me to understand better some of the pathfinder laws: To keep the morning watch means I will have a prayer and personal Bible study each day. Keep a song in my heart means I will be cheerful and happy and let the influence of my life be as a sunshine to others. To be courteous and obedient is to be kind and thoughtful of others, reflecting the love of Jesus in all my association with others."

**Joshlen shares her experience** on friendship development: "I was lucky to get to go and meet Gail, Theo, Tessa, Alyssa and Terry. Elder Brenya, Jeffrey and I were at Seaside Court which was surrounded by a small park and a graffiti wall. We stood at number 20 where Alyssa welcomed us to her house. I felt quite shy entering somebody's house as I am very loud, unexpectedly we were just in time to help celebrate Terry's 39th birthday! Honestly, I was amazed at Gail's painting of her dad, it was very detailed and she explained her technique very clearly. In my opinion, Theo (who is 19 months old) was very friendly and smart for his age, he sure knows how to solve puzzles! I didn't find a lot about Tessa but I do know she loves gymnastics also she has autism. After getting introduced to everyone, we sang a song, 'Jesus loves me.' Before we left we prayed. In conclusion, I had a great time and I hope I see them all at messy church!"

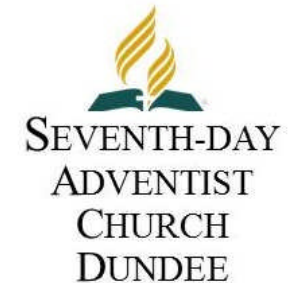
