Essence of the Gospel

As I was walking along the corridor of the department where I work one day a young student passed by me wearing a black T-shirt. On it was written his message in large letters "I'm not dead yet". Would you wear a shirt with that message? What does it say about the student? Does he think people are trying to kill him and he has so far escaped? Has he got a persecution complex? Or is it that he is a chronic hypochondriac? He feels he is suffering from terrible ills and ailments but so far has managed to survive? Or is it that he just feels his mortality? Life is short - death is inevitable?

It was remarkable because not many young people feel like that! I think the gospel - the good news - is really for such people, young or old, who don't want to be swallowed in the oblivion of death. That's actually what our lesson studies are about this quarter too. Paul tells us in Romans 6: 23 "For the wages of sin *is* death, but the gift of God *is* eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord."

Matthew records that a young man came to Jesus and said "Good Teacher, what good thing shall I do that I may have eternal life?" Jesus replied "Why do you call Me good? No one is good but One, that is, God. But if you want to enter into life, keep the commandments." John makes things simpler and clearer in chapter 3 of his gospel, vs 14: "And as Moses lifted up the serpent in the wilderness, even so must the Son of Man be lifted up, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have eternal life. For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life." In chapter 17 he added the following:

"And this is eternal life, that they may know You, the only true God, and Jesus Christ whom You have sent."

Life contains many ups and down, stresses and strains, problems and pains. Amongst all this we sometimes lose sight of what is really at stake in the world - it's nothing less than our eternal lives. Studying our Bibles, seeking for the inspiration and enlightenment of the Holy Spirit, engaging in earnest and persistent prayer - that's how we get to know "the only true God, and Jesus Christ whom You have sent." There is nothing more important!
