Helping Young Families

'*Servina others as Jesus did*' is the theme of the Week of Prayer readings for this week. Being a practical Christian by *doina* the will of God is also the theme of this quarter's SS lessons. I'm sure each of us would like to be a loving and loveable Christian in our community.

One activity that our Dundee church is involved in, meets the community's needs so well that they want more of it! It happens on Tuesday mornings between 10 and 12 noon when about 25 neighbours of the church bring their children or grandchildren to the Toddler group run in our church hall. While the children play with a wide variety of toys, the adults sit around and chat. Some ask about the church, while others discuss personal concerns. There is always such a happy atmosphere that one new mum said only last week, 'This is the highlight of my week. I look forward to coming all week.' Others have praised the cleanliness of the carpet, toys and toilets compared to other places!

Most of the children like the 'craft time' which they do with their parents. They then take their 'work of art' home with them. So when Messy Church comes round with crafts on a Biblical theme, they are all invited. The children who have attended have really enjoyed it.

Some of the parents like reading stories to their children. So four times a year each child who attends is given a free Bible story book to take home to enjoy at leisure. One mum says she reads it to her child each night!

The city of Dundee has one of the highest levels of child poverty in the country. We've seen one foster child, who wouldn't come into the hall, but hid under the table in the foyer, bloom into a confident chatty toddler through having some consistent happy time with us each week.

The 'new' parents appreciate the support and feeling of togetherness they experience, so much so that they often bring another new mum to join the group!

So please pray for the toddler group. Pray that the passive witnessing, through the Christian posters and displays and the books given out, may have a lasting influence on their lives. Pray too that the fun and friendship that is enjoyed by all of the 70+ families who have attended over the years may open hearts to the influence of Jesus.

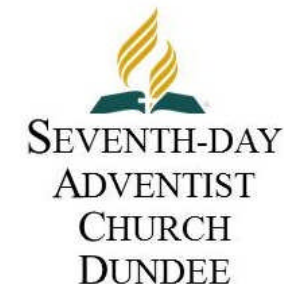
