An Adventurer's Best First Impression

One day the delighted eight-year old boy returned from school with a drawing of a boy in an Adventurer's uniform. When I enquired about his drawing he proceeded to tell me his story. 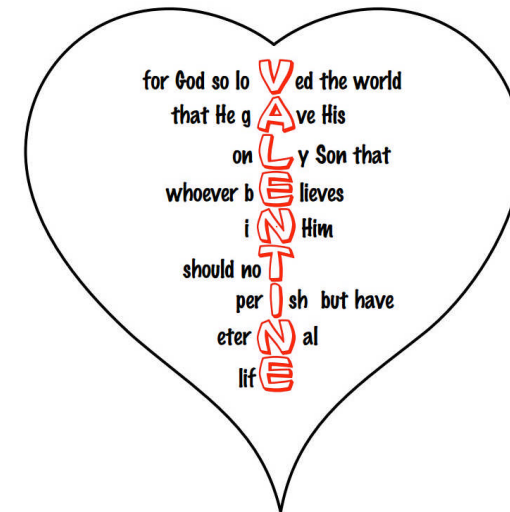
