**About Being Intentional – 1 Timothy 4:15**

Recall for a minute the effort involved in studying: the lectures, the assignments, the reading, the exams, etc. Some of these memories are pleasant; some less so. However, formal studying is part of all our lives. How would you feel if at the end of a course of study (1, 2, or 4 years), you would realise that you haven’t really learnt much. What if you can’t remember anything from what you studied? How would that make you feel? All the sweat, the tears, the late nights and the sacrifices were for nothing.

The reality is that most people have attended church for years. Some have attended for many years. Would it not be a tragedy if after all these years, you realise that you haven’t learnt much!? Will it not be a sad reality if you have attended some, and read some and tried to memorise some, but when you check there isn’t much there?

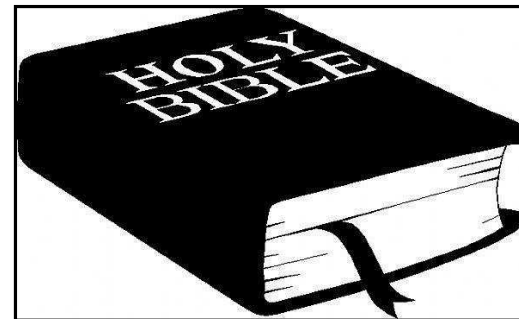
