Praise Him – Ps. 22:3

Claudette and I read this week in one of our devotionals a verse which reflects the sentiments of many others in the Bible: Ps 22:3 - But You are holy, O You Who dwell in [the holy place where] the praises of Israel [are offered].

It challenged us, of course, because it is easy to fall into a negative routine of focusing on the negative and forget to give praise where praise is due. This is especially true when it comes to God – we are quick to moan and complain, but slow to thank Him. And yet, the Bible is filled with people who learnt to praise and be thankful, in spite of the circumstances they faced. This reminded me of a story I read not too long ago:

A 92-year-old, petite, well-poised and proud man, who is fully dressed each morning by eight o'clock, with his hair fashionably combed and shaved perfectly, even though he is legally blind, moved to a nursing home today. His wife of 70 years recently passed away, making the move necessary.

After many hours of waiting patiently in the lobby of the nursing home, he smiled sweetly when told his room was ready. As he maneuvered his walker to the elevator, I provided a visual description of his tiny room, including the eyelet sheets that had been hung on his window.

"I love it," he stated with the enthusiasm of an eight-year-old having just been presented with a new puppy.

"Mr. Jones, you haven't seen the room; just wait."

"That doesn't have anything to do with it," he replied. "Joy is something you decide on ahead of time. Whether I like my room or not doesn't depend on how the furniture is arranged. It's how I arrange my mind. I already decided to love it. It's a decision I make every morning when I wake up. I have a choice; I can spend the day in bed recounting the difficulty I have with the parts of my body that no longer work, or get out of bed and be thankful for the ones that do. Each day is a gift, and as long as my eyes open, I'll focus on the new day and all the happy memories I've stored away. Just for this time in my life..."

There is so much we have to be thankful for. Perhaps it will be worth taking a minute to give thanks to God for the good things we can experience in life. Let us praise Him, for He is good!

May you remember His goodness and be grateful for it!

May you intentionally praise Him, in spite of the circumstances!

May you decide in your mind that no matter what comes, you will focus on that which is good and that which matters!

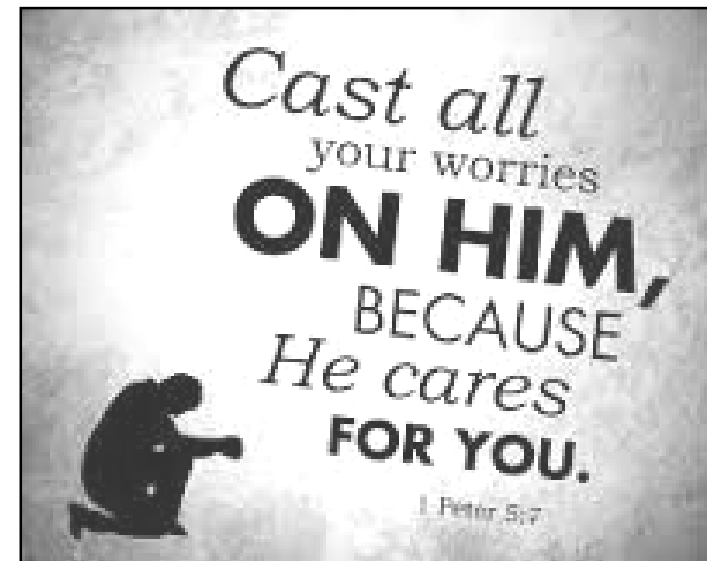
