### A Different Kind of Journey

Many embark on a journey for different reasons. Recently, we heard of the fate of hundreds of migrants fleeing Africa through Libya across the Mediterranean for the purpose of finding a better life in Europe. It was confirmed that more than 800 people were missing or dead in this latest Mediterranean Sea disaster. For two of our young people, this Sabbath will mark the beginning of a different kind of journey. Both of them have made a crucial decision to respond to the invitation to follow Jesus—not an easy decision when many young people are today seduced by a different leading for a variety of reasons.

We have known Mervyn for a considerable number of years. He is a talented young man and very active in church. We are grateful to God for his life. He is a gift entrusted not only to his parents but to our church community. I remember when Naomi joined us, the first time I noticed her in church was with her dad--Shy but an intelligent and determined young woman. She has been another wonderful gift to our church community. Over the years, she has consistently helped with both the Adventurers and Pathfinders. I sat in some of the Bible studies and I heard the questions asked by these young people, I felt the excitement as they explore the Bible, and demonstrate the desire to know more about God's will. When we respond to His call we start the journey with Jesus. As disciples we are expected to place ourselves at the Master's disposal, although we retain the right to dictate our own terms—not an easy task.
