THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK
<u>So, what’s new?</u>
<p>Young people love new gadgets, new ideas, new challenges, new opportunities, and treat everyone a day older than themselves as ancient, irrelevant, and non-cool!</p> <p>Now, let’s not be hasty here and think badly of the young people in church today. Remember, you were once their age, and just as fascinated by the new technology and opportunities of your day. Admittedly, the technology was not as easily portable as today’s, but the sermons probably appeared just as boring and apparently as irrelevant to us then as today’s sermons may appear to this generation.</p> <p>As you look around church today and see young heads bowed down and thumbs working overtime, what should your reaction be?</p> <p>I am sure most of you will be familiar with the Serenity Prayer which is a beautifully crafted request to our loving Heavenly Father, and goes like this:</p> <p>“God grant me the serenity to accept the things I cannot change, Courage to change the things I can, And wisdom to know the difference,”</p> <p>One thing is sure, we do not want to change youthful curiosity and thirst for knowledge and new experiences! But have you noticed how as time passes, the enthusiasm of our past youthfulness has changed into an acceptance of a dull monotony of the familiar and a reluctance to accept change in any form?</p> <p>I was interested to discover this slight variation on the Serenity Prayer which may help us to see how we can help those restless thumbs to be still, and youthful minds be captivated by what they hear in church.</p> <p>“God grant me the serenity to accept people I cannot change, The courage to change the one I can, And the wisdom to know – it’s me!”</p> <p>How much thought and effort do we put into making church interesting and relevant to the young people? Are we so stuck in our comfortable familiarity with regimentation and routine, the old familiar clichés and ‘church-speak’ that we leave young minds searching for excitement elsewhere? Or are we willing to see that we need to change to meet the challenges of spiritual life for both ourselves and our young people in 2016?</p> <p>I’ll leave you to answer this question for yourselves.</p> <p>Pastor Neil Robertson</p>
