<b>THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK</b>
<b><u>Relationships &amp; Challenges</u></b>
<p>Colossians 3:13-14</p> <p>Make allowance for each other’s faults, and forgive anyone who offends you. Remember, the Lord forgave you, so you must forgive others. Above all, clothe yourselves with love, which binds us all together in perfect harmony.</p> <p>Generally speaking, it's very easy to write off people simply because of the way they behave which is not compatible with our life. Some can be a thorn in your back side to the point where you may say, 'why on earth did I get to know this person?' You may even take a step further and say 'I am not even going to consider re-engaging or giving this person a second chance'. But Paul comes in with a calm advice 'Make allowance for each other’s faults, and forgive anyone who offends you. Remember, the Lord forgave you, so you must forgive others'. In our Christian life we have brothers and sisters who are so burdensome to a point where it’s so much easier to relegate them to the back of our memory: but what they need is forgiveness. This is a big challenge to many of us, who come to church to worship God and fellowship with others, as we often go home drained out of the living daylights and deprived of the Sabbath blessings to a point where we curse the whole Sabbath day.</p> <p>As a way of self-protection it becomes much easier to wish away trouble makers. What is interesting is that, these individuals who constantly wrong us, drain us and tire us have been put in our lives for a reason. Each time they do something annoying, we can learn one or two positive things. One may say; it's easy said than done and that's true. But learning from Biblical figures entrusted with the word of God, the more challenges they met, the more their ability to deal with difficult people and circumstances improved.</p> <p>In simplistic terms, looking at every prophet and other God's messengers' life you can clearly see how the nasty experiences they encountered shaped the person they became. It is my view, probably it is the view of many that some challenges especially those coming from brothers and sisters of faith, are aimed at shaping you into a better person. Even if their behaviour is overwhelming, do not despair it could be that you are being tested and you will come through refined. Take for example, for about 5 years, Saul tormented David to a point where he had to run, and run, and run for his life, and all this was aimed at developing his ability to endure future challenges and ultimately develop both leadership abilities and qualities. It could be argued that during this (running away period) David learnt the principles of love, kindness, humility, patience, forgiveness and perseverance. Ultimately The LORD never allowed for the people who tormented him and tried his patience to succeed in their desire to steal from his intended destiny. Just like in David's experience, challenges seek to develop in us a Christlike person, and yet at the time of the experiences, it would not appear as such.</p> <p>This week, I will encourage you to take time to re-evaluate your relationships and experiences with brothers and sisters. Look closely at the relationships you have written off and see how you can salvage them. Where possible, look for the positives that can be taken from the past, and give those that you can a second chance and more importantly continue to grow as a child of God.</p> <p>Remember, as you grow in your ability to deal with difficult people and circumstances, your spiritual life will improve. You graduate through the various schools of life and you will be taken up to your ultimate place of positioning (salvation).</p> <p>Great endings come from terrible beginnings.</p> <p>Tarzan Bhebhe</p>
